For fiber cable materials only, expect \$0.52 per foot for wholesale bulk purchases, or \$1 to \$6 per foot at retail. The wide price range reflects differences in fiber strand. Market size: The Canada Offshore Fibre Optic Cable Lay market is estimated at USD 340–420 million in 2026, driven by new Arctic connectivity projects, trans-Pacific cable landings, and hyperscale data centre expansion. Growth is forecast at a compound annual rate of 6–8% through 2035, reaching USD.
