The National Electrical Code (NEC), published as NFPA 70, sets minimum safety standards for electrical junction boxes in residential and commercial buildings. 28: Requires junction boxes to be made of non-combustible materials like stainless steel, aluminum, or UV-resistant plastic. 16: Dictates volume size in cubic inches, requiring 18 cu in for 3 to 6 conductors and 20 cu in for 7 to 8 conductors.
