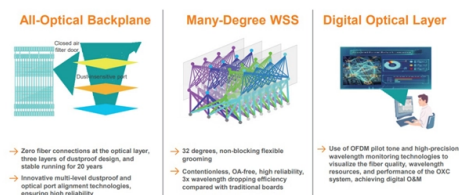

For North American distribution box compliance, you need UL 1741 6 certification for solar applications, conformity to NEC Article 690 7 requirements, and NEMA enclosure ratings 8 (minimum NEMA 3R for outdoor use).
