The aggregation layer serves as the convergence point for multiple access layer switches and is responsible for handling all. This arrangement increases throughput beyond what a single relationship could sustain, offers redundancy in case one of the links. Link aggregation is a way of bundling a bunch of individual (Ethernet) links together so they act as a single logical link.
